


Existing Land Use

- Buildings were digitized from 1989 1:5000 orthophotos by the University of Maryland under contract with WRC. Locations and type have been checked by the Town of Marlboro Planning Commission. These data respresent conditions in 1994.
- Parcel boundaries were taken from the VGIS PARCEL layer for Marlboro. These data were derived from 1:5000 town tax maps representing 1991 conditions.
- Conservation land data were obtained from WRC mapping, the Town of Marlboro, and the Vermont Conservation Lands Database developed by UVM Spatial Analysis Laboratory in 1999.
